Corner of Norrie Avenue and the circle at the bottom of McKeurtan Avenue.
(approximately opposite the Pizza Parlour).

DATE: WEDNESDAY the 7TH JULY, 1982. TIME : 5.15 p.m. for 5.30 p.m.

RUN NO. 43 : JAMES DIXON (or was it CELFYN THOMAS)
